Instructions

You will need: one set of cards per group

- Divide students into small groups of three or four, and give each group a set of cards, face-down in the middle.
- Students take it in turns to take a card and read out the sentence beginning. Other students listen to the sentence beginning and try to complete it, using a verb in the correct form. Whoever completes it correctly first, wins the card. The student with the most cards at the end of the game wins.
- Monitor and help where necessary, giving advice on whether sentences are correct.
