Instructions

You will need: one set of cards per 12 students. If you have more than 12 students, then make another copy of the cards and double up.

- Give one card to each student in the class and make sure they don't show it to anyone else. Give students time to complete three statements beginning *I'm always ... , I love / like ... , I won't ...* which would fit a person being described on their card. Students then think of other ways to describe the typical behaviour of a person with this character trait.
- Go round and help with ideas and vocabulary where necessary, writing any new words/phrases on the board.
- When they are ready, students move around the room and say their three sentences to other students, who then try to guess what the character trait is.
