Instructions and Answer Key

You will need: one worksheet, a coin and counters per group of students

- Divide students into groups of three or four, and give one copy of the worksheet to each group.
- Students place their counters on the *START* square, and take it in turns to flip the coin to see how far they move (heads = one square, tails = two). When they land on a square, students complete the sentence using the word in brackets in the correct form. However, if they land on a shaded square, they must not only complete the sentence but talk about the topic for a minute.
- If a student lands on one of the star squares, they must create a sentence using one of the words in the middle of the board.
- The winner is the first player to reach the *START* square again.
