Instructions and Answer key

You will need: one copy of the board and one set of Question cards per group of three or four students; dice and counters

- Put students into groups of three or four. Give each group a copy of the board, a set of *Question cards* (shuffled), dice and counters. Tell students to put the *Question cards* face down in a pile on the appropriate space on the board, and their counters on the *START* square.
- Students take it in turns to throw a number. If Student A lands on a square with a question mark on it, he/she must pick up a *Question card*. He/She should place the card down so that all the students can read it, then try to answer the question.
- If the other students think that the answer is correct, Student A stays on the square. If the answer is not correct, or Student A cannot answer the question, he/she should move back to his/her original square. If the students cannot agree, the teacher adjudicates (see Answer key).
- If a student lands on a square with a speech bubble on it, he/she must talk about that topic for 15 seconds without stopping. (If one of the students in each group has a watch with a second hand, make him/her the timekeeper). If the student cannot think of anything to say, or stops talking before the 15 seconds are up, he/she must return to his/her original square.
- The first student to reach the *Finish* square is the winner. Groups who finish first can go through the *Question cards* and check their answers.
