Instructions

You will need: one set of cards per pair of students

- Divide students into pairs (or groups of three). Give each pair (or group) a set of cards and tell them to spread them out in front of them face down, with the bigger cards on one side and the smaller cards on the other. Shuffle the cards before the class.
- Students take it in turns to turn over one big card and one small card. If the word matches the picture, the student keeps the cards as a 'trick' and has another turn. If the cards do not match, the student must put them back in exactly the same place.
- The activity continues until all the cards are matched up. The student with the most tricks is the winner.
- If one group finishes early, they can test each other by holding up the picture cards and asking their partner for the correct word.
