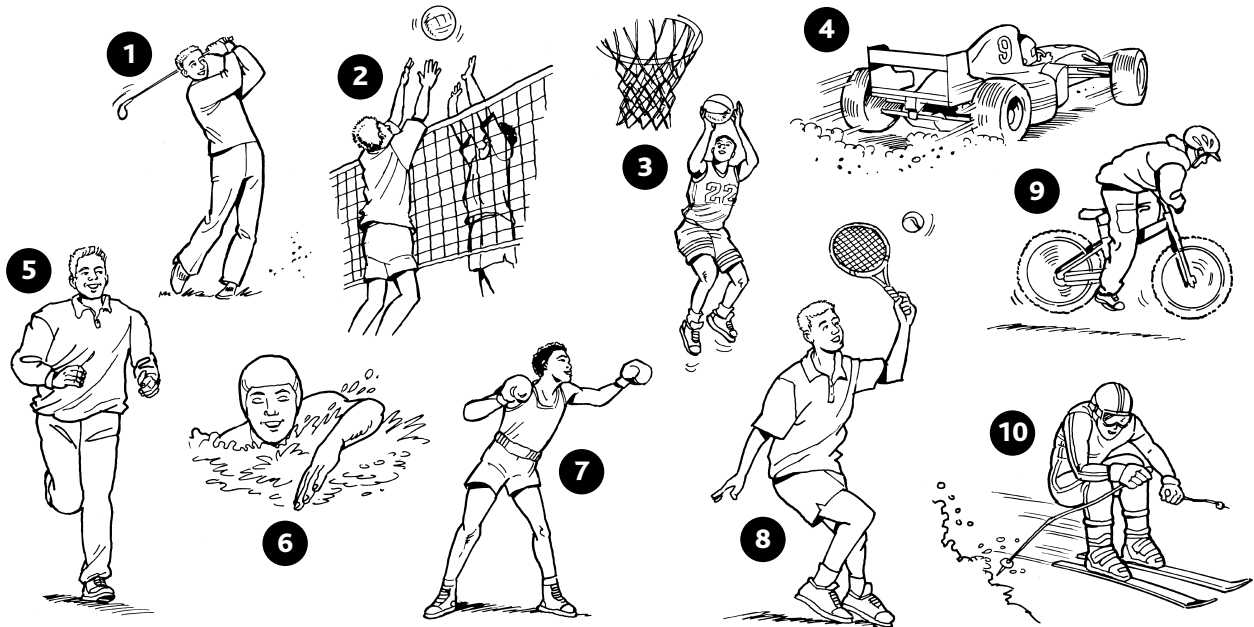

## Instructions and Answer key

*You will need: one copy of the worksheet per student*

- Give a copy of the *worksheet* to each student, and allow them to do Exercise 1 alone or in pairs. Check the answers with the whole group (see Answer key).
- Ensure that students can pronounce the new vocabulary items before allowing the students to do Exercise 2 in pairs.
- Students work in pairs or small groups and do Exercise 3. This stage could also be done as a mingle activity if it is possible for students to move around the room.
- Students work individually and do Exercise 4. Put the class into pairs or small groups and allow them to compare their answers. If you are working with a monolingual group, you may want to teach the English words for other popular sports in their country before they begin this exercise.
