shower sofa table TV wardrobe

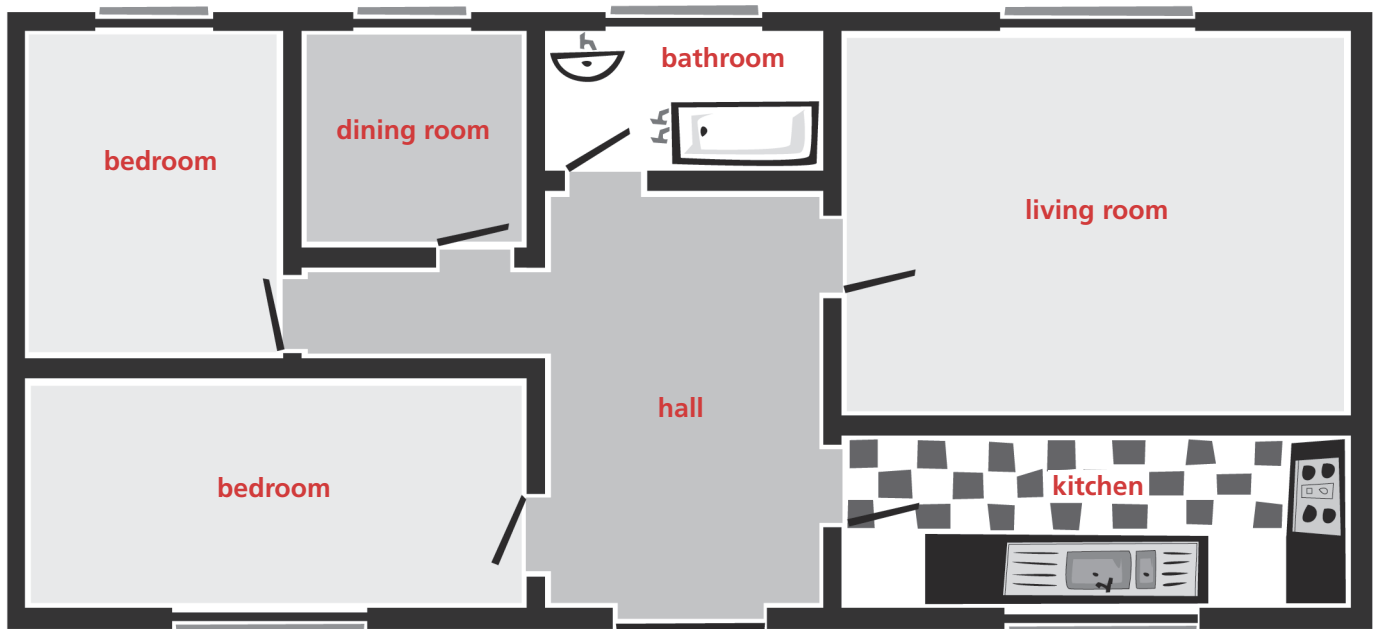
2 Student A: Say where the objects are in your house. Use *in, on, behind, between, in front of, and opposite*. For example:
